1. **Action item:** Change of Program Outcomes – **BSN**

In preparation for NLNAC national accreditation, a revision in the student learning outcomes was essential. The proposed student learning outcomes were developed by BSN faculty with the support of the associate director for the RN to BSN program and the vice president of academic affairs. We are expecting to have a site visit for full accreditation, and it is vital that the student learning outcomes be appropriate for the level of our students. Applicable date would be Fall 2012. 2. Action item: New Course Proposal – TPP 2300: Directing I

This course is an introduction to directing for the stage and also examines the processes of production management of both people and resources. Applicable date would be Fall 2012. **Presenter**: Stuart Brown

3. Action item: New Course Proposal – TPP 1606 PLAYWRITING

This course explores the of process, playwriting styles, and techniques employed in the writing of dramatic texts. Applicable date would be Fall 2012. **Presenter**: Stuart Brown

4. Action item: New Course Proposal – TPA 1210: STAGE CRAFT I

This course is an introduction to the terminology, methods, tools, and materials employed in stage lighting, sound, and construction and combines lecture and a lab setting. Applicable date would be Fall 2012. **Presenter**: Stuart Brown

5. Action item: Change of Program – AS NETWORKING DEGREE

Currently, the networking administrator degree and networking certificate are inconsistent. GEB 1011 Introduction to Business is for both the degree and certificate because both are enhanced by a basic business understanding for how the course outcomes will be applied in a job related assignment. For the AS networking degree, GEB 1011 will replace ACG 1001 as a degree core requirement. Applicable date would be Fall 2012. **Presenter**: Dr. Douglas Nay

6. **Action Item:** Change of Program Prerequisite to Co-Requisite – **MAN 2021 PRINCIPLES OF MANAGEMENT**

Currently, MAN 2021 is a program prerequisite for the Supervision and Management Baccalaureate Program. Changing MAN 2021 to a co-requisite for this program enables more efficient registration and completion of the degree. The 2012-2013 catalog will state that MAN 2021 must be taken within the first semester of upper level coursework. Applicable date would be Fall 2012. **Presenter**: Dr. Douglas Nay

7. Action item: Change of Program – SUPERVISION AND MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

Proposes to change the graduation requirement from the present 75% on the comprehensive business exam (CBE) to 75% on the Capstone Post Course Exit Exam to help guide needed curricular changes. The CBE does not apply to AS business degrees. Applicable date would be Fall 2012. **Presenter:** Dr. Douglas Nay

- 8. Action item: Change of Program BUSINESS BACCALAUREATE DEGREES
 Proposes to change from the I.A.C.B.E. Comprehensive Business Exam to the
 Educational Testing Service (E.T.S.) Major Field Test (MFT) for Business Baccalaureate
 Degrees. THE ETS test is more widely accepted and more statistically valid. Applicable
 date would be Fall 2012. **Presenter**: Dr. Douglas Nay
- 9. **Action item:** Change To Course Prerequisites **ENT 3003 ENTREPRENEURSHIP** Proposes to eliminate the course pre requisites of SBM 2000, Small Business Management or GEB 1011, Introduction to Business for new elective. Neither course is required to achieve the learning outcomes of ENT 3003. Applicable date would be Fall 2012. **Presenter:** Dr. Douglas Nay
- 10. **Action Item:** Change To Course Prerequisites **MAN 4113, UNDERSTANDING AND MANAGING DIVERSITY and MAN 3081, INTRODUCTION TO E-BUSINESS**Proposes to change the mathematics requirement from 6 hours to 3 hours for two new electives introduced this semester, MAN 4113, Understanding and Managing Diversity and MAN 3081, Introduction to E-Business. The course requirements should not be more rigid than the degree requirements. The mathematics required in the course learning outcomes is minimal. Applicable date would be Fall 2012. **Presenter:** Dr. Douglas Nay
- 11. **Information item:** Change of Course Outcomes **INR 2002 International Relations** The changes in the course outcomes allows for the use of multiple databases, provides uniformity in wording of the assessments section with other course syllabi, and limits general education competencies to documentable assessments. **Presenter**: Laura Weir
