THE COMPREHENSIVE BUSINESS EXAM (CBE) FROM THE INTERNATIONAL ASSEMBLY FOR COLLEGIATE BUSINESS EDUCATION (I.A.C.B.E.) GIVES BROAD BASED DATA ON EIGHT MAJOR BUSINESS AREAS AND IS NOT SPECIFIC ENOUGH TO BE ABLE TO MAKE IMPROVEMENTS IN COURSE CONTENT OR EMPHASIS IN REQUIRED COURSES. THE CAPSTONE POST TEST IS SPECIFICALLY TUNED TO OUR LEARNING OUTCOMES AND TAKEN FROM MID TERM AND FINAL EXAMS OF THOSE REQUIRED COURSES. OUR LEARNING OUTCOMES HAVE BEEN PREVIOUSLY BEEN REVIEWED BY THE BUSINESS AND TECHNOLOGY ADVISORY COMMITTEES AND WILL BE PRESENTED AGAIN FOR DISCUSSION IN THE
