Using the search bar available in the gray box, will let you perform a general search by keyword, title, author and subject. Simply select the field you wish to search from the drop down menu next to the search bar.

If you need to perform a more in depth search selecting the tab “Advanced Catalog Search” in the gray box will bring up a screen like this:

Search by will let you search by several different fields at once. This is helpful if your first search was unsuccessful. You can search by keyword, author, subject, and title. You can also change Boolean operators. See link for more info on [Boolean operators](#).

At: Lets you chose the location you want to search, you can search by specific Edison campus to see what’s available where you are. You can also widen your search to include any of the 28 state colleges in Florida.

Click “Search” to run your search

Format: allows you to chose the specific type of resource you would like to find: a book, an eBook, a DVD, an audio file etc.

Language: gives you the option to select the language you would like your source to be published in

Year: Year to: allows you to find sources published in a specific year or range of years

After you hit "Search" your search results will look something like this:

This is the title and author name of the book

You can see the location of the book here. In this case the book is at the Hendry Glades Center

This grouping of letters and numbers is called the call number, and it helps you locate the book on the shelf. The word circulation means that it's in our circulating collection so it's freely available for check out.
