<p>THIS COURSE INTRODUCES STUDENTS TO FARO FOCUS 3D, ADVANCED, 3 DIMENSIONAL CRIME SCENE SCANNING AND LASER IMAGING HARDWARE/SOFTWARE. THIS TECHNOLOGY IS CURRENTLY BEING ADOPTED BY FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AND INVESTIGATIVE AGENCIES TO ENABLE DIMENSIONALLY ACCURATE, 360 DEGREE, COMPUTER GENERATED GRAPHIC IMAGES FOR USE IN MEASUREMENTS, ANALYSES, AND RECONSTRUCTIONS OF CRIME AND/OR ACCIDENT SCENES AND TO AID IN MORE ACCURATE AND COMPELLING COURTROOM PRESENTATION. STUDENTS ASSEMBLE, CALIBRATE, AND OPERATE THE TECHNOLOGY THROUGH VARIOUS INDOOR AND OUTDOOR CRIME SCENE SCENARIOS AND GENERATE MEASUREMENTS, ANALYSES, AND REPORTS CONCERNING THOSE SCENES.</p>

THE CRIME SCENE PROGRAM OBTAINED STATE OF THE ART FARO 3D IMAGING TECHNOLOGY TO ENHANCE PROGRAMMATIC OUTCOMES AND TO PROVIDE GRADUATES WITH A COMPETITIVE ADVANTAGE IN SEEKING EMPLOYMENT IN FIELD. THE FACULTY ANTICIPATES ASKING FOR CURRICULUM COMMITTEE APPROVAL TO INSERT THIS COURSE INTO THE AS CRIME SCENE DEGREE AS A CORE COURSE. THIS TECHNOLOGY IS JUST NOW BEING ADOPTED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES SO HAVING THE ABILITY TO OFFER THE COURSE IN SPRING AS AN ELECTIVE FOR BOTH AS CJ AND ASCS STUDENTS WILL ALLOW BETA TESTING AND DEVELOPMENT TO OCCUR BEFORE THE COURSE IS ADOPTED IN THE CORE.
