# 4. Student Affairs Report:

a. SB1720 (Presenter: Dr. Christine Davis)

Dr. Davis presented this item for discussion. Dr. Davis, Dr. Wright, Dr. DeLuca, Laura Antczak and Andrae Jones created a PowerPoint presentation regarding SB1720. Dr. Davis explained that Student Affairs would create a comprehensive advising plan to assist students with choosing a major and future career path. Laura Antczak referenced and covered part of the presentation outlining the proposed enrollment model, admissions process, and redesigned orientation. Andrae Jones discussed the revised advising process and SB1720 dashboard form. Dr. DeLuca reviewed the implementation plan specifically, developmental education strategies, student placement testing, developmental education exemption, Gateway courses and the Quality Enhancement Plan.
