## Guidelines:

The information outlined below clarifies intent and provides direction for the application of said procedure.

## **Procedures:**

Only currently enrolled students are authorized to be in classrooms, except for situations involving a properly documented disability. Children, friends, spouses, or other relatives are not permitted, except with permission of the professor. Field trips, science laboratories, and classrooms might incur a safety hazard or a space limitation. Each college department should provide guidelines for these special situations. Complaints regarding classroom disruption should be reported to these offices.
