1. It was discovered after the final curriculum meeting of 2014-2015 that the prerequisite for BSC 2008C needed to be updated to accommodate the addition of the new BSC 1005C course that was approved by the committee.

New prerequisite language for BSC 2008C effective Fall 2015:

(SB 1720 Testing Exemption or successful completion of all Developmental courses) and (BSC 1005C, BSC 1005, any higher-level biology course, or high school biology) with a grade of "C" or better

2. It was discovered after the final curriculum meeting of 2014-2015 that the course description for BSC 1084C included Edison State College.

New course description language for BSC 1084C effective Fall 2015:

This is a one semester combined lecture/lab course in human anatomy and physiology. It includes principles and concepts of chemistry and biochemistry. Concepts related to the cell and tissues are covered in conjunction with concepts related to the structure and function of the body systems. Each system is presented in sufficient depth to provide students with a comprehensive understanding of the human body. This course is an introduction to anatomy and physiology, chemistry, the cell, tissues, and the following systems: integumentary, skeletal, muscular, nervous, endocrine, cardiovascular, lymphatic, immune, respiratory, digestive, urinary, and reproductive.
