- Community of Practice feature within CANVAS
 - Proposed shell for SoBT presented by M. Goby
 - To be used as alternative to email when sharing information
 - Also to be used to share updated documentation, such as syllabi
 - All faculty to be contributors
 - SLS Community of Practice was shown as example
 - T. Rath explained that this feature will be helpful for accreditation documentation
 - M. Goby can add links to training opportunities within the Community
 - M. Engdahl suggested a module for each course within the Community and a general module for general information pertaining to all courses
 - D. Hoffman pointed out the benefit of reaching out to adjuncts within the Community
- Master Courses
 - M. Goby expressed importance of well-maintained master course shells and presented an example of revisions within a master course
 - Faculty agreed that creators of master courses will maintain those courses
- Rubrics
 - D. Hoffman presented a sample course rubric and pointed out Learning
 Outcome descriptions

- o Importance of data collection and statistical analysis was discussed
- It was agreed that Learning Outcomes will be reviewed and revised to match course activities if needed
- o D. Hoffman stated that Learning Outcome mastery will be defined as 80%.
- Adjunct Office
 - The need for an adjunct work space was discussed and D. Hoffman will look into the possibility of a vacant office
- MAN 2021 Master Course
 - MAN 2021 Master Courses is not complete. D. McCabe and J. Patterson agreed to work on it per approval from T. Rath
