What is it?

- Formal communication system to identify and intervene with at-risk students in a timely manner

Who manages the EA program?

- Academic advisors, academic support services, and campus deans

How is EA governed? Early Alert Committee

Best Practices in Early Alert Programs:

- Identifying pre-college characteristics associated with student success
- Initial outreach by identifier
- Early alerts should be..... early
- Closing the loop

Our Early Alert Process:

- Alert
 1. First and foremost, faculty outreach to students
 2. If additional intervention needed, faculty submits early alert request
- Intervention
 1. Advisor reviews case to determine level of intervention
 2. Advisor performs outreach to student
 3. Advisor communicates with faculty after each outreach attempt

Early Alert Goals in 16-17:

- Increase awareness with a focus on adjunct faculty
- Offer opportunity for non-faculty members to make early alert referrals
- Integrate pre-college at-risk characteristics identification and referrals into the enrollment process
