SCNS has questioned a second ISM 4220 course that was proposed by the School of Business and Technology. The proposal for ISM 3220 that was approved in February is withdrawn.

The current ISM 4220 will replace ISM 3220 on the catalog page in the proposed new BAS, Information Systems Technology program.

The ISM 4220 course will need to be updated to add program registration restrictions for two of the baccalaureate programs in the School of Business and Technology: BAS SMAN and the registration code for the BAS, Information Systems Technology that is created by the Registrar.
