Last meeting the committee identified made several recommendation to recognize each individual who was nominated for the Cornerstone Scholar and Peer Architect of the Month awards. The committee agreed to provide a certificate to all nominated winners and to recognize nominated Peer Architects in the monthly Peer Architect team meeting. Whitney reported that the Peer Architects were very happy to receive recognition in front of their peers during the Peer Architect team meeting.

The committee reviewed the nominated students for the Cornerstone Scholar of the Month and Peer Architect of the Month for the month of October.

The committee discussed ideas for future feature stories and recommended featuring good deeds completed by students (a pay it forward concept), featuring a students with a particular interest or hobby, highlighting student athlete (balancing academic, sports, etc.), highlights students who have passion for a specific subject, featuring non-traditional students and why they returned to college.

The committee reviewed a draft of the November FYE Community Update and recommended featuring veterans for Veterans Day.

The committee discussed the Critical Thinking Lecture Series. Whitney shared that **92.62%** of surveyed student participants "strongly agree" or "agree" that the speaker(s) were interesting and understandable and **89.00%** of surveyed student participants "strongly agreed" or "agreed" that the topic was interesting and informative. This data is from the first six Critical Thinking Lecture and a total of 691 survey responses.

Whitney stated that we have on-camera interviews for four of the guest presenters and asked the committee to think about a name for the video series.

The group will continue to think about and discuss guidelines for spring 2017 Cornerstone Photo Contest at the November QEP Marketing Committee.
