This course change was discussed with Garnett Salmon, Registrar; Dr. Joyce Rollins, Coordinator of Elementary Education; and Dean Larry Miller, School of Education. The change was discussed in light of registration issues students experienced as they related to this course and its existing pre-requisite of EDM 3230, a course that was not offered during Fall 2016. This change merely reflects the program change approved in Spring 2016 that allowed Middle Grades Language Arts students to take EDG 3620, Curriculum and Instruction, a course historically required in Elementary Education, in lieu of EDM 3230, historically taken only by students in the middle and secondary programs.

During registration for Spring 2017, Middle Grades Language Arts program students experienced registration restrictions for LAE 3324c due to its existing pre-requisite of EDM 3230, a course that was not offered to these students during Fall 2016. In Spring 2016, Curriculum Committee approved a request that EDG 3620, Curriculum and Instruction, become a replacement for EDM 3230, Middle Grades Curriculum and Instruction, which would no longer be offered due to low enrollment. The change to prerequisites for this course is in alignment with the program change.




