#### Field of Flags in the Taeni Hall Lawn:

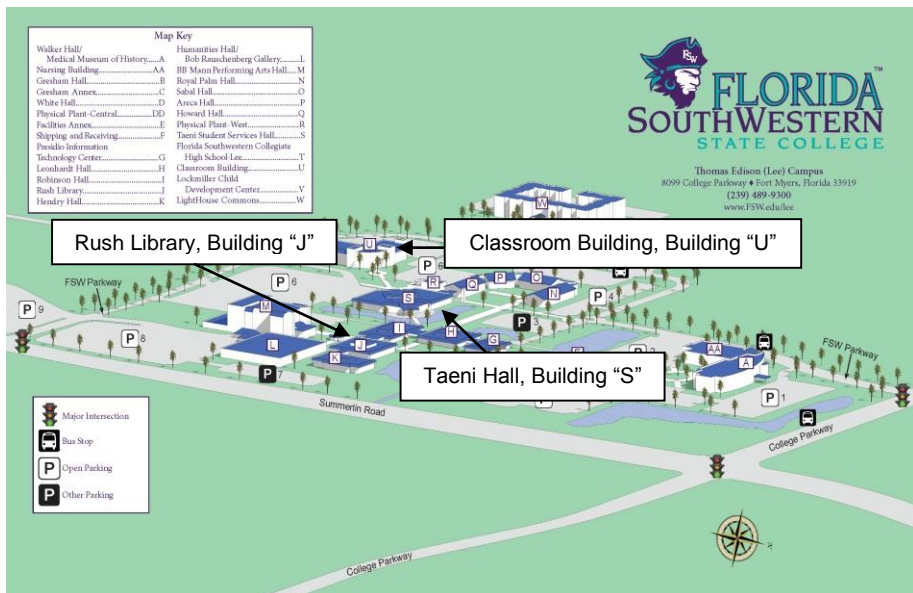
