Field of Flags in the Taeni Hall Lawn:

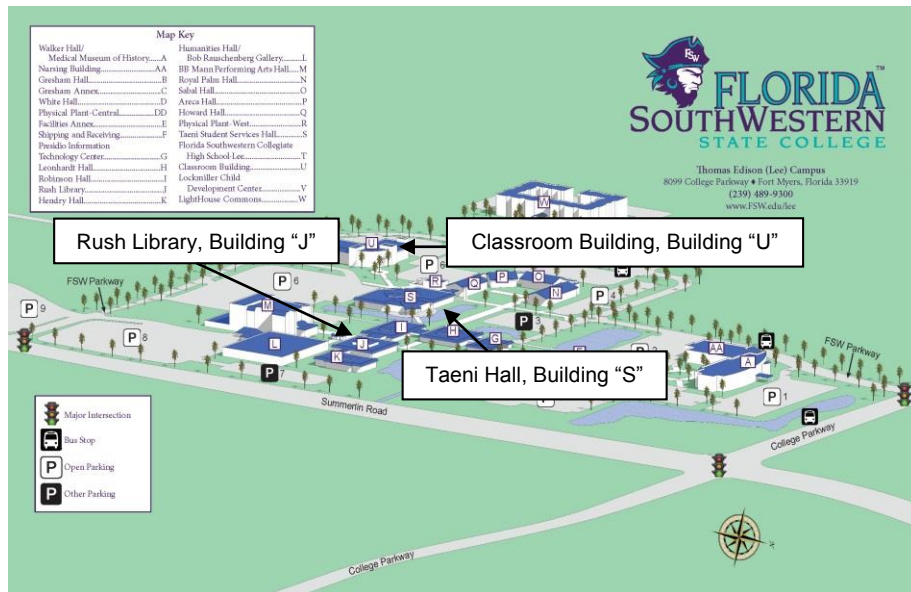

The display is on loan from the Holocaust Museum & Education Center of Southwest Florida

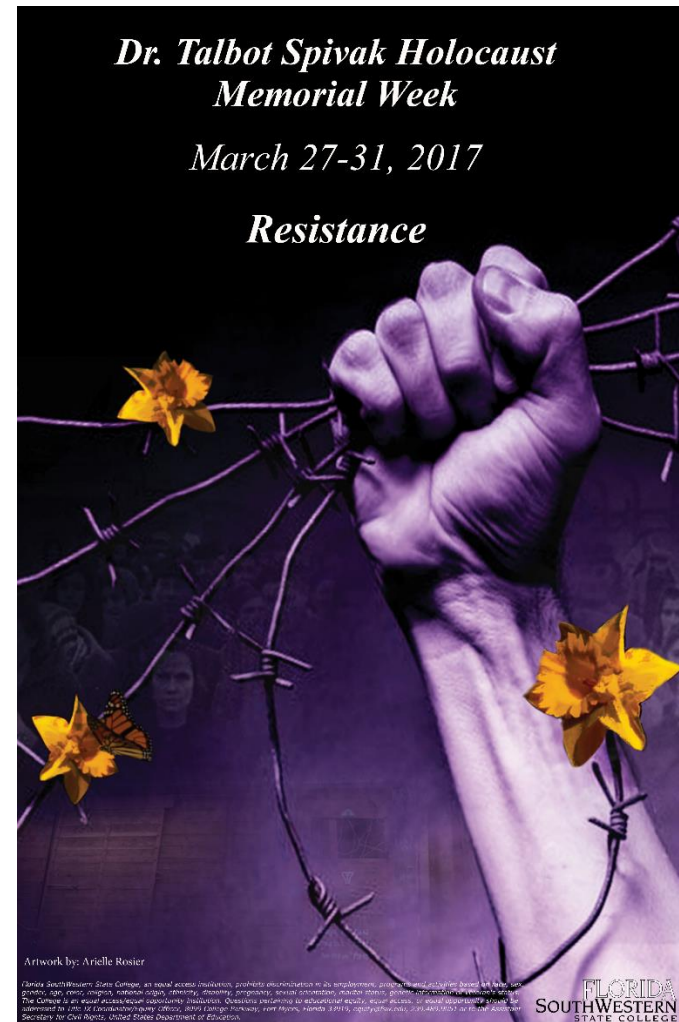
Poster Display in Building "U" Lobby:
