

MINUTES
School of Education Meeting
September 28, 2011

Meeting commenced at 12:00 PM

In attendance: Professor Elaine Schaeffer, Professor Mary Robertson, Dr. Regina Miller, Professor Joyce Rollins, Dr. William Dwyer, Dr. Cathleen Doheny, Dr. Anne Angstrom (via Polycom) and Barbara Miley.

- I. Professor Rollins opened the meeting with an activity where everyone in attendance shared their music preferences.
- II. Professor Rollins stated that we need to be consistent with our Service Learning. The variety of experiences should bring the students' learning around full circle. Faculty steward should be conducting two one hour meetings with the students (one at the beginning of the semester and one at the end of the semester). - III. Professor Rollins stated that the following unit goals will be taking place between now and April: full-time and adjunct faculty will be better trained in the technology that they use, we will be working with community agencies for service learning opportunities, and our students will mentor First Year Experience students that indicate Education as a possible major. It was suggested that the training for mentoring be incorporated into Classroom Management. We also need to think about ideas for ways we can teach our students to be good mentors
