- II. Service Learning Rollins
 - a. Students have until midnight, September 19, 2012 to make selection
 - b. The 'Other' box was for students not fitting in any category
 - c. Will not accept activities from Church. Need to keep a separation of Church and State
 - d. Service learning has to be above and beyond jobs.
 - e. Students must have a first and second choice before meeting with faculty
 - f. 'Other' will not be an option for Spring 2013.
 - g. Students with extenuating circumstances must meet with Faculty. Faculty will contact agency to see if they qualify.
 - h. Propper has been getting several questions about Service Learning hours. Student must make a folder and be responsible for their own documentation.
 - i. Doheny Where is list of activities?
 - j. Rollins Through Survey Monkey in the SOE Groups on the Portal.
 - k. Robertson How long is Edison e-mail active after graduation?
