Counseling Services

- Disclose incident in a confidential environment.
- Available on each campus.
- Licensed mental health counselors.
- Information discussed is not shared with FSW or police.
- For counseling after business hours, or in an emergency, call the local rape crisis center.
- Counselor from Abuse, Counseling and Treatment Center available Thursdays on the Thomas Edison campus.



Advocate Services

- Angie Snyder, S-258
- Disclose incident in a confidential environment.
- Located on the Thomas Edison campus.
- Details discussed are not shared with FSW or police but date/location are reported for Clery purposes.
- For services after hours call the local rape crisis center.
- Provides list of available resources.

Campus Safety

- Report an incident on campus or other FSW property.
- Reports incident to Title IX Coordinator.
- Can issue a no contact order and assist with obtaining a restraining order.
- Contact local law enforcement to report an incident off FSW property.
- Victim has the ability to decide if they want to file criminal charges.



Title IX Coordinator

- Report an incident on or off campus.
- Investigates reports and takes action to stop violence on campus from occurring and prevent its recurrence.
- Reports incidents (date/location) to Public Safety for Clery reporting purposes.
- Provides list of available resources.
