In the past students who were enrolled in the audio technology certificate program were not aware that MUM 2600C can be taken at the same time as MUS 2360 because it is currently listed as a prerequisite only. By changing the requirement to Co-Requisite it will allow an unobstructed pathway for students to enroll in both MUS 2360 and MUM 2600 at the same time without the need of an add form.

Moving forward students will be able to take MUS 2360 Introduction to Technology in Music (3 credits) either as a pre-requisite to MUM 2600C Basic Audio Recording Techniques 1 (3 cr.), as a corequisite with MUM 2600C, or as a stand-alone elective.

This will assure students will be notified during registration that they can either take MUM2600C after they have completed MUS2360 or at the same time.
