		• If you wish to join a group and haven't responded yet, do so soon! If you have already contacted her after the email, then you'll be contacted soon by the TLC when/how to begin.
		• To be certified to teach online courses this fall, your option is Cohort 3. If you are not on the list and are interested in the training, please let Peggy know ASAP.
		• As of now, only adjuncts have been placed in this cohort, but full-time faculty will have preference. Our number one priority is to ensure that you will be able to make your full-time teaching load.
		• Faculty who have already completed the certification for online teaching do not need to retake the course.
		• Online teaching certification does not necessarily mean you can develop a course, it only makes you eligible to teach an online course that has already been developed. Once you are certified, if you want to develop your own course or a master course, you can request to join the DEV 101 course.

		 final assessment for analysis. 2. Continue to monitor that the 9 learning outcomes that improved from Spring 2019 to Fall 2019 are maintained or determine if the improvement was an anomaly.
