CHAIR Dr. Sheila Seelau VICE CHAIR Professor Kelsea Livingstone 1 **INFORMATION ITEM** Type of proposal Change of Course Presenter Dr. Anita Rose Memo: Course Equivalency ENT 1000 = ENT 2000 **Effective Date: Fall, 2020** Summary of proposed changes: Clarifies that ENT 1000 Introduction to Entrepreneurship and ENT 2000 Introduction to Entrepreneurship are equivalent courses. Add notation to ENT 2000: "Students who have completed ENT 1000 will have met the requirements of ENT 2000." Course number ENT 2000 replaced ENT 1000 via a Course Change Proposal in Dec. 2019. ENT 1000 was retained in the system until further notice to aid in matriculation of current students. However, course equivalency notations were not completed in all systems. Without the equivalency notation on both courses, students who have taken one of these courses must repeat work if their program requires the other course. Adding the equivalency information to each course rectifies this oversight.
