Summary of proposed changes:

Florida Department of Education along with the Florida Division of the State Fire Marshal has changed the Certificate program hours from 398 to 492 hours effective July 1 2020. The FSW effective term is therefore 2019-2020.

State mandate distributes the increased hours across the two required Certificate courses, which have been renumbered as a result: FFP 0010C Firefighter I is replaced by FFP 0030C Firefighter I (191 hours), and FFP 0020C Firefighter II is replaced by FFP 0031C Firefighter II (301 hours).

New Course proposals for FFP 0030C and FFP 0031C and Course Discontinuation proposals for FFP 0010C and FFP 0020C are included to effect these changes retroactively to 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 Catalogs.
