After much research regarding the workforce needs for the Intermodal Transportation CCC, and after meeting (see attached minutes) with Dr. Timothy Lucas – original developer of the Intermodal Freight Transportation courses, Dr. Debbie Psihountas - Dean of SoBT, Dr. Jennifer Patterson – Chair of the Business and Accounting Department, and Keith Robbins from the Florida Department of Transportation, it has been determined that the demand in the workforce for the application of the Intermodal Freight Transportation CCC for jobs within the current workforce is limited. Therefore, the Intermodal Freight Transportation CCC should be eliminated from the SoBT program offerings. The courses included in the Intermodal Freight Transportation CCC: AVM 2120 - Air Cargo Operations, TRA 1410 - Introduction to Rail Freight Operations, TRA 1420 - Introduction to Trucking Operations, TRA 1430 - Introduction to Port Freight Operations, TRA 2010 - Introduction to Transportation and Logistics, and TRA 2402 - Intermodal Transportation Operations are specific and unique to that program, each of the courses should be eliminated.
