Summary of New Program:

Many other state colleges in Florida offer workforce training certificates and degrees in the field of Music Production, but there are no AS or Certificate programs offered at any public institutions between the Tampa vicinity (SPSC) and Miami area. We would be filling a geographical niche, as well as meeting a need in our community. Here in southwest Florida, there are many performing arts venues, arenas, television and radio networks, small production companies and churches that employ complex sound systems and require certified technicians to manage their hardware and software. Through completion of this program of study, graduates may potentially obtain employment as recording technicians/engineers, sound technicians in "live" or studio positions, and as audio editors and sound designers in various other music-related fields. Additional coursework will help prepare students for the business aspects of a career in music, including the study of legal issues involving copyrights and contracts, management skills with an introduction to entrepreneurship, and the importance of fostering working relationships throughout their careers within the music industry.

Summary of proposed changes:

Florida Department of Education along with the Florida Division of the State Fire Marshal has changed the Certificate program hours from 398 to 492 hours effective July 1, 2020. The FSW effective term is therefore 2019-2020.

Attachments include 14b) FL DOE Curriculum Framework for Firefighter Certificate (including Firefighter I & II course restructuring); 14c) Fire Academy training curriculum criteria; 14d) FSW Firefighter I/II Certificate PSAV Catalog page (in .docx and .pdf formats), and 14e) Memo signed by Dr. DeLuca approving exceptions to effective dates for program changes.

Accompanying proposals (Items 15-18): State mandate distributes the increased hours across the two required Certificate courses, which have been renumbered as a result: 15) FFP 0010C Firefighter I is to be discontinued and replaced by 17) FFP 0030C Firefighter I (191 hours), and 16) FFP 0020C Firefighter II is to be discontinued and replaced by 18) FFP 0031C Firefighter II (301 hours).

For the cohort that had already entered the program in Summer 2020 (D term) before the mandated changes, FFP 0010C clock hours (206) were decreased to 191, and FFP 0020C clock hours (192) were increased to 301. These courses are to be discontinued at the end of Fall 2020. Replacement courses FFP 0300C and FFP 0031C are to begin in Spring 2021.

Course Discontinuation proposals for FFP 0010C and FFP 0020C, and New Course proposals for FFP 0030C and FFP 0031C are included to effect these changes retroactively to 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 Catalogs.
