 - Assessment info provided by Eric in a September 2020 email he sent to D'ariel that I don't recall receiving) is below:
 - 1) I will work with the department chair to send out messages to our faculty regarding your office's plans for Scantron distribution. This will be relevant for AMH2010, ECO2013, and ECO2023.
 - 2) DEP2004, PSY2012, and POS2041 will be using Canvas only to collect assessment data, so you need not worry about those courses.
 - Below is Eric's response to me requesting he contact me mid-semester with assessment protocols and I'll contact all f/t and p/t faculty:
 - I agree we should get something together early in the upcoming semester and make sure we get it out to everyone that matters. After the first time, we can pretty much use the same memos every semester.

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- SS monthly Coffee Talk/Commun of Practice—f/t & p/t volunteers to lead a casual discussion on a topic that we all can relate to
 - Yes by some faculty, no response by others; will try and see how it goes (many are Zoomed-out!)
- Curriculum Sheila Seelau
 - o By next year, the full proposal will be entered online
 - o Jan 11, 2021 deadline for new course proposals
 - As part of Syllapalooza in spring, we will need to do a Doc Manager sweep to check that all Syllabi are up-to-date.
 - We should also check syllabi for courses "on the books" but not currently being taught. These are more likely to have been missed when GenEd changed in 2016-17. We can also decide if we want to keep those courses active or Discontinue them. We didn't get a 5-year discontinuation memo from State DOE/SCNS this year, probably due to COVID, so this will give us a jump on decision-making before we're hit with that in September.
 - Although course and syllabus changes approved in spring would not go into effect until Fall 2022, it is best to bring these issues to committee in Spring when Curriculum committee is less swamped with higher-priority proposals.
 - Shelia has been in contact with Dawn and Leslie about Child & Adolescent Dev, as I know these syllabi need updating. They made modifications to syllabi when they started offering the courses 2 years ago (?) but Course Change proposals were never submitted through Curriculum for official approval. This means these courses are out of alignment for SACSCOC review.
 - Jacque needs to revise Abnormal Psych one more time to resolve SCNS issues as well—changing CLP 2142 to CLP 2140.
- Camille is now our Social Science rep on Curriculum, so perhaps the three of us can
 meet to determine how to get this review done. The discipline faculty will need to make
 changes, then submit to Chair and Curriculum point person for initial review and
 determination of whether Course Change proposals are also necessary. I will "train"
 Camille on this.
- Other business...
 - Bruno Baltodano New POS course proposal ISS XXXX needs to be reloaded, endorsements had been secured at last meeting; will be reloaded in Curriculog soon so I/chair can sign off.
