- I. Oct 2 2020 Minutes Approved
- II. Fall Semester Programming Recap
 - Discussed attendance numbers and increase from last year possibly due to Zoom increasing accessibility
- III. Spring Semester Programming
 - Similar programming as fall semester (lectures, book chats, contest)
 - Dr. Maetzke shared idea of film viewing party
 - “The Help” race relations, connect to Ignorance chapter of 21 Lessons, Feb-Black History Month
 - Looking into copyright, use of Films On Demand
 - Dr. Jett introduced idea of Wrap Up Party
 - Opportunity to “wrap up” 21 Lessons, major takeaways, send off, bring 21 Lessons to a close
 - Contest-slogan or logo design contest to promote new OBOC book choice
 - Build excitement for Fall 2021
- IV. Data Collection-Efficacy-Achievement of OBOC Goals
 - Discussed idea of surveying participants after each event, post assessment
 - Use Zoom data to send surveys out to OBOC event participants (discuss with AASPIRE)
 - “Wrap Party” as way to gather qualitative data
 - Similar to a focus group, hand select people to provide feedback
 - Target faculty who have used 21 Lessons in courses
 - Ask professors for names of students who participated in OBOC events
