RF: AP Environmental Science Exam

The State of Florida requires that students who receive a 3 or above on the AP Exam in Environmental Science be giving credit for ISC1051, a class within the State Course Numbering System that is specifically for this purpose. Since we do not offer this class, it transfers into FSW as an elective course, rather than a General Education Science course. The science department reviewed the course work for the AP Environmental Science course and found that it meets more than 70% of the learning outcomes of our EVR1001C class (the coursework does require lab work)

Recommendation: A student with an AP Environmental Science score of 3 or more should receive credit for EVR1001C
