(SOAP) is to assist Florida SouthWestern State in identifying and providing help to students who are having academic

difficulties.

Guidelines:

The intent of Standards of Academic Progress (SOAP) is to inform students that they are not making expected academic progress. Students are required to meet with a Student Success Advisor to discuss ways of improving their academic status and set goals to improve.

Procedures:

The procedures of SOAP are managed by a committee based on data and best practices. Academic Advising and Student Success Advisors enforce the procedures and guidelines.

Standards of Academic Progress

To complete degree and certificate program requirements, students are required to maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of "C" (2.0 on a 4.0 scale) or better. The Director of Academic Advising or designee sends written notification to each student placed on various academic standings.
