### Current College Student Admit Plan

(100)<sup>1</sup> current college students will be admitted each fall and spring semester. All current college student applicants will receive a score based on their GPA in the (9) general education courses they have completed that are required for ASN graduation. The top (140)<sup>1</sup> scoring applicants will be selected to interview and test with the Nursing department. Those items will be scored and added to the applicant's initial GPA score. The top (40)<sup>1</sup> scoring applicants will be selected for admission to the ASN program.
