(40) high school graduates will be admitted each fall and spring semester. All high school graduate applicants will receive a score based on their high school GPA. The top (60) scoring applicants will be selected to interview and test with the Nursing department. Those items will be scored and added to the applicant's initial GPA score. The top (40) scoring applicants will be selected for admission to the ASN program.
