<b>Network Systems Technology AS</b>	<b>Effective Date: Fall 2021</b>		
<b>Summary of proposed changes:</b>			
Adjusting course requirements in Network Systems Technology AS pending SACSCOC approval of BAS in Information Systems Technology. Adding CNT 1512 <i>Wireless Network Administration</i> and CGS 1100 <i>Computer Applications for Business</i> to program core requirements [also required for the BAS]. Removing SPC 1017, SLS 1331/1515, and (previously discontinued course) CGS 2108 from program requirements allows 3 credits to be redistributed to "Approved electives," resulting in a total of 6 credits in this category. PHI 2100 changes from <i>required</i> to <i>recommended</i> among a choice of "Any (3-credit) GE Humanities."			
<b>Addenda:</b> CEN prefix added to specified electives under "Any 1000 or 2000 level computer course."			
On Catalog page, cleaned up CGS 2108 and CGS 1100 language from last year's curriculum action.			
No change in overall credits to degree. Catalog page with tracked changes and State AS Frameworks are appended.

**New for 3/5/21 meeting:** *AS Networking State Frameworks Justification* document added to support the department's decision to move forward with the original proposal as planned.

**Summary:** By Statute, AS degree programs do not require SPC 1017. SLS 1515 is a College requirement, not a program requirement. 12 FSW AS programs do not require Speech, and 10 do not require SLS 1515. 5 AS programs include 3 or more credits of open electives. The current proposal contains 6 credits of open electives where either or both courses may be counted if taken.

Also included in this document: State Frameworks for *Communication* for AS NST degree, and mapping to required courses CIS 2321 and CTS 2142. SPC 1017 GE competencies and CLOs are included for comparison and contrast.

[SLS 1515 may be counted here.] Removing "Any 1000 or 2000 level CGS, CNT, COP, or CTS course – 3 credits" and replacing with specific course CNT 1512 <i>Wireless Network Administration</i> (3 credits), which is required for the BAS. [SLS 1515/1331 may be counted here.] Removing "Any 1000 or 2000 level COP or CTS course – 3 credits" and replacing with: COP 2700 <i>Database Programming</i> – 3 credits. <b>NUR 2144 Pharmacological Nursing</b>	<b>Effective Date: Fall 2020</b>		
<b>Summary of proposed changes and explanation of effective date:</b>			

**Action:** Prerequisites change from list of all sequential prerequisite courses to only the final course: NUR 2092 with a grade of C or better.

**Effective date** is an exception to the Curriculum calendar due to an oversight on a previous action approved at 2/5/2021 meeting. NUR 2145 was Discontinued, and New Course 2144 was created as its equivalent by SCNS order, with DeLuca-approved Memo enabling action retroactively effective to 2020-2021 Catalog. On the New Course proposal, changes to the prerequisite list were also made. Because this change constitutes an Action, it was not covered by the Info Item/Memo and the Committee requested a separate Course Change proposal. This proposal is therefore a continuation of a set of changes begun in November 2020, thus the request to retroactively apply the same effective date.

Syllabus with tracked changes and impact reports for NUR 2144 and former/equivalent course NUR 2145 included. There is no impact on other courses or programs, as this change is to the course prerequisites.

<b>Effective date:</b> The effective date stated (Fall 2021) is an exception to the Curriculum calendar timeline (Course Change proposals received after 1/11/21 deadline go into effect in Fall 2022), so will need Provost’s approval. JP/SS added an Exception Explanation to the Proposal document, which has been uploaded to Curriculog and rerouted through the Provost. Revised version appended.
