- In anticipation of the new BAS in IST, we need to add a class to the AS degree in Computer
 Programming and Analysis. The class is COP 2700 Database Programming 3 credits. Students
 need a database fundamentals course before beginning the BAS.
- To add this 3-credit course to the Core requirements, we are removing one of the specified
 Electives (any 1000 or 2000 level computer course with a COP or CTS prefix 3 credits).
- Additionally, the SLS 1515 or SLS 1331 Core requirement is being removed. The three credits will be redistributed to Electives as: Any 1000 or 2000 level course - 3 credits.
- The result is that the core stays at 42 credit hours and Electives at 6 credits, with one open elective and one specified elective.

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
