NUR 2144 is a new course that is equivalent to NUR 2145. The impact report for NUR 2145 shows three related courses: NUR 2033, NUR 2033L, and NUR 2424. These courses are not affected by this course change proposal because the only change is to the course prereqs.

Exception to start date = Fall 2021; 2021-2022 Catalog Explanation for exception:

During the February 5, 2021 Curriculum Committee meeting, while discussing the new course proposal for NUR 2144 Pharmacological Nursing, it was realized that a change of course proposal was needed to include the pre-req change since the new course was replacing an equivalent course (number change required by the state) and was an information only item. The change in pre-req will require an action by the curriculum committee. Because the prior Course Discontinuation/New Course was required by SCNS to go into effect immediately, the prior Info Item had a retroactive effective date to Fall 2020/the 2020-2021 Catalog.

The requested adjustment to prerequisites in this proposal does not change the required prerequisites but simplifies the course description by deleting the full series of stacked prerequisites and leaving only the final course in the list, consistent with the new curriculum. We are requesting that the change to prerequisites for this course be effective in Fall 2021 when the first cohort enters the new ASN curriculum.
