- 2. Highlights of yesterday's Paralegal Advisory Committee meeting: cover letters should be required in every paralegal course; nominee needed from member of the public.
- 3. Paralegal Studies Program enrollment increased from 81 students in 2019 to 121+ in 2021. Paralegal employment is booming. Students need to proofread their resumes/cover letters and look at law firm websites before job interviews. Plan jobhunting workshop for Paralegal Studies students in Summer 2021 &/or Fall 2021..
