## Florida SouthWestern State College ASN Program COVID-19 Clinical and Simulation Acknowledgement Form –Fall 2021

Because of the ongoing COVID-19 Pandemic, it may be necessary for nursing students to travel outside of their campus area to complete clinical and/or simulation experiences if experiences are not available at local clinical sites. The clinical hours, if available, will be completed at facilities associated with Florida SouthWestern State College in Collier, Lee, and/or Charlotte counties. Students will be responsible for following FSW program and clinical site policies for any assigned clinical experiences. When, due to the pandemic, clinical experiences are not available, students may be required to travel to other campuses for simulation experiences that will replace clinical hours. Because the situation with the COVID-19 pandemic is constantly changing, it may be necessary to make alterations in clinical/simulation schedules throughout the semester.

Healthcare facilities that provide nursing students with clinical experiences may decide at any time to require COVID 19 vaccinations. When this occurs, nursing students will not be able to attend planned clinical days to that facility without first uploading proof of proper COVID 19 vaccinations to Castlebranch. Because of this, nursing students who have not received COVID 19 vaccines may have difficulty obtaining the clinical experiences required to pass a clinical course.

Nursing students are not able to transfer to another campus to avoid missing days related to vaccine requirements. Students also cannot complete missed clinical time in simulation or vSim if there are clinical opportunities available. The decision to require COVID 19 vaccines is determined by clinical sites, not FSW. We are required to abide by their policies.

I have read the above statements and understand that due to potential necessary changes in clinical schedules during the semester, I need to be available to attend <u>all</u> clinical and simulation days, relating to my clinical course.
