The hospital has made this request because they notice new grads who are fearful of going into isolation rooms because they have not been allowed at all since the pandemic began</li> <li>All agree that it will be good experiences to allow Level 3 and 4 students to care for patients with COVID when hospitals allow them to, but not Level 1 or 2 students. Concerns were raised because this will involve only students who are vaccinated; how will this affect clinical groups. Currently Fawcett hospital requires the clinical instructor to be present on the floor where there are students.
