1. Standard 1 Mission and Administrative Capacity A. Discussion on allowing ASN students to take Pathophysiology, Pharmacology or Adv. Health Assessment at the 3000 level if they met criteria.		Meeting purpose to continue discussing topic continuing from 3/12/21 during the department meeting to allow Faculty and Staff ability to discuss topic further. B. Holbrook had shared bullet points of discussion of topic on 3/12/21 via email (2021-03-26 Handout 1) and sent to faculty. 3-12-21 Proposal: Director will approve a <i>BSN Major</i> override for select ASN students to take Pathophysiology, Pharmacology or Adv. Health Assessment if meet qualifications listed below:

- ASN student must have completed Level 2 Nursing classes
- hold a 3.0 average or higher in ASN courses (not including gen ed courses)
- completed A and P I & II and English Composition
- Potential students would notify Dr. Terrence Hays, Advisor of their interest in taking an RN-to-BSN course; Dr. Hays will determine if student meets criteria
- ASN students understand federal financial aid cannot be used to pay for these classes
- students who are reimbursed by employers need to check with employers if these courses are covered.

Faculty Concerns:

- End of Level II is too early to allow ASN students take Patho, Pharm or Adv. Health Assessment haven't learned enough about nursing yet.
- We need to wait until the dual track is approved for college catalog in Fall 2022.
- Only allow ASN graduates who are pre-NCLEX take the three 3000 level courses
- ASN students during COVID pandemic have not had enough clinical practice time to be able to take 3000 level courses
- These students need to be followed for RN-to-BSN tracking of completion for 150% of expected Program completion which will decrease success rates

Motion was made to change criteria of ASN students who would get Director approval only if they meet the following criteria:

- *ASN students must have a Florida AA degree or higher or have completed BSN required general education courses to qualify*
- *ASN students must have completed Level 3 in ASN Program before being permitted to take Patho, Pharm or Adv. Health Assess.*
- *ASN students must have a 3.0 grade or higher in ASN nursing courses*
