FSW's BSN program will prepare you to take on new nursing roles including:

- Leadership in a variety of settings
- Work as a school nurse (minimum BSN required)
- Work in public health departments (minimum BSN required)
- Parish nursing and home care
- Serve the nation as a military nurse Army, Navy, Air Force, National Guard (minimum BSN required)

Our online courses are focused on elevating your professional nursing practice and are based in research, community health, multicultural nursing, informatics and leadership knowledge and skills.

You will learn from faculty with extensive experience in education and nursing service. Many of our faculty members have held leadership roles or are currently practicing in the community, which enhances your learning opportunities.
