## Curriculum Committee extended membership and Curriculog roles

## Summary:

Curiculum Committee members-at-large (non-voting) and Curriculog reviewers have been added to the file: 2021-2022 CC Roster & Curriculog Review Groups (appended).

## **Curriculog Workflow and Roles**

Course, Program, and Certificate action item proposals submitted by faculty in Curriculog are entered into a workflow for review and approval when the *originator* "Launches" and approves his/her own proposal. Reviews proceed through the Department *Chair* (or Program Director), School *Dean* (and associate deans), to the *Curriculum Coordinator and Advising (CCA) group* (including Registrar's, Advising, and Student Affairs personnel). Proposals move to Team *AASPIRE*, then to *Curriculum Committee* for review, discussion, and vote.

The *Provost* reviews all approved proposals and prepares a summary for the next BOT meeting. Meanwhile, proposals recirculate to the *Coordinator of Curriculum and Catalog Systems* to be entered into Banner and FSW records, and to AASPIRE for SACSCOC report preparation as necessary.

Legislative updates and curricular effects: HB 1507	

## Summary:

HB 1507 General Education requirements change for AS Programs (effective 2022-2023): Pending DOE development of language integration into Florida Administrative Code (FAC) Rule 6A-14.0303, General Education Core Course Options. All AS programs must include at least one Core course from each of 5 GE areas (Communication, Humanities, Social Sciences, Natural Sciences, Mathematics). Anticipate Program/Certificate Change proposals for 23 AS Programs and some bachelor's programs needing GE updates.

Submission deadline for these proposals is currently 12/6/2021 for a special meeting to be held 1/7/22.

\*PLEASE ADVISE on deadline to allow sufficient time for reviews. Proposals cannot be launched until the new DOE Rule language is made available – anticipated in October.

Legislative updates and curricular effects: SB 1108	
Summary	

SB 1108 Civic Literacy competency requirement change (effective 2021-2022): Pending DOE language adjustments to FAC Rule 6A-10.02413. AA degree requirement to demonstrate civic literacy competency requires successfully passing (POS 2041 or AMH 2020) AND passing a civics literacy exam or assessment defined by the state. [Language change from OR to AND.] State is developing a new test in addition to those already offered. FSW Catalog will be updated once FAC Rule is enacted. No course or program change proposals are anticipated.

However, it is anticipated that the state may apply the civic literacy requirement to AS and baccalaureate programs, effective 2022-2023. All AS, BS, and BAS programs should consider this possibility as they review the GE portion of their programs under CB Item 4. This change would apply to the GE Core Social Science course selection.
