



Justification for course discontinuation*



If SLS 1101 is discontinued and the Registrar cannot set it up in Banner to meet the college requirement for years taken before 2021-22, students can apply for an SLS 1515 exemption.

If the learning outcomes differ between SLS 1101 and SLS 1515, this was not caught until now. Course equivalencies were never established in the catalog.

An exemption was apparently set such that students who successfully completed SLS 1101 were exempted from taking SLS 1515 to meet the College Requirement. This is a course substitution, which does not necessarily imply course equivalency.

Discontinuation of SLS 1101 should not affect this exemption for re-admit or transfer students.
