Deleted (SPC 1017 or SPC 2608) [-3 CR], which is an extra Communications requirement under the new AS GE Core requirements. Students may be advised to take SPC as an Elective.	
Added GE Core Natural Sciences (Recommended: EVR 1001C) [+3 CR]. FDOE recommends EVR 1001C <i>Introduction to Environmental Science</i> as a companion course to Program Requirement BSC 1040. (See below)	
Moved ECO 2013 [-3 CR of GE] to the list of Electives [no Electives CR change]. ECO 2013 is no longer required for the program but may be taken as an elective. This made room for addition of GE Core Social Sciences with CL recommendation [+3 CR of GE].

BSC 1051C <i>Environmental Biology: Southwest Florida Ecosystems</i> deleted (-3 CR) because it is not a Construction course, thus not foundational for the degree. Required Foundation course BCN 1040 <i>Introduction to Sustainability in Construction</i> covers environmental systems/processes. Five required courses meet the same FDOE Framework standard as BSC 1051C.	
Foundation Courses decrease from 19 to 16 CR, and Program Requirements decrease from 47 to 44 Credit Hours.	
<b>Electives:</b>	
ETD 1949 <i>Engineering Technology Internship</i> deleted. It more appropriately applies to the Civil Architecture A.S. Degree. Advanced Program Requirement ETD 2930 <i>Capstone</i> is the equivalent for the ADCT, AS degree.	

Consistent with other programs, two lines were combined at the top of the Electives section: "Electives may be taken from the following 1000 and 2000 level courses" and "or any course with the following prefixes...". This now reads, "Any 1000-2000 level courses with these prefixes: BCT, BCN, EET, or ETD" **OR** (list of specific courses follows).

Electives increased from 1 to 4 credits to offset decrease above. Program total = 66 Credit Hours.

Deleted (SPC 1017 or SPC 2608), which is an extra Communications requirement under the new AS GE Core requirements. Students may be advised to take SPC as an Elective. [-3 CR]	
Added GE Core Natural Sciences (Recommended: EVR 1001C) [+3 CR].	
Moved ECO 2013 [-3 CR of GE] to the list of Electives [no Electives CR change]. ECO 2013 is no longer required for the program but may be taken as an elective. This made room for addition of GE Core Social Sciences with CL recommendation [+3 CR of GE].

<b>Program Requirements - Foundation courses:</b>	
BSC 1051C <i>Environmental Biology: Southwest Florida Ecosystems</i> deleted [-3 CR] because it is not a construction course, thus not foundational for the degree. Required Foundation course BCN 1040 <i>Introduction to Sustainability in Construction</i> covers environmental systems/processes. Other required courses meet the same FDOE Framework standards as BSC 1051C. FDOE recommends EVR 1001C <i>Introduction to Environmental Science</i> for this degree. This course recommendation was added to the (new 3 CR) GE Core Natural Sciences requirement.	
Foundation Course Requirement decreases from 19 to 16 CR.	
<b>Program Requirements - Advanced courses:</b>	
Deleted (MAC 1140 or ISC 1101C or PHY 1020C or STA 2023). [-3 CR]	
Increased MAC 1114 Trigonometry from 3 to 4 credits (approved by CC 2/4/22). [+1 CR]	



**Deleted notation** that "MAC 1147 (5 CR) can be taken in place of MAC 1140 and MAC 1114 along with one extra elective credit." [CC note: We believe this means students could take either (MAC 1147 & 1 CR Elective = 6 CR) or (MAC 1140 & 1114 for 6 CR).]

Advanced Course Requirement decreases from 24-25 credit hours to 23. [CC note: We believe the former credit hours = 25 for either option so (variable CR = 24-25) was an error.]

**Electives:**

As noted above, ECO 2013 was moved from GE Requirements to Electives list.

ETD 1949 was removed from the Electives list because it is covered by the list of constrained electives. Consistent with other programs, two lines were combined at the top of the Electives section to read: "Any 1000 or 2000 level courses with the following prefixes: BCT, BCN, EET, or ETD" OR (additional electives list follows).

These changes did not affect the total Electives CR hours. Department proposed increasing Elective total from 1-2 to 3 CR Hours to offset credit reductions in Advanced course requirements.

Pending FDOE reduction of CET AS credit hours from 63 to 60 for AY 2022-2023, 3 credit hours must be deleted from the degree program. After all changes above, GE = 18, Program = 39 (Foundation = 16, Advanced = 23), and Electives = 3; total credit hours for AS degree = 60.

**Note to Registrar:** Program Requirements correction needed on "Select one of the following Natural Science courses." CC approved this requirement on 2/13/2021, but it was entered incorrectly in the catalog. *CHM 1045/1045L should be CHM 2045 and CHM 2045L.* Please make this change in 2022-2023 catalog and in the addendum to the 2021-2022 catalog.

**Note to Department:** Program Requirements include, "Select one of the following Natural Science courses." *All Program Requirements should be mapped to Framework standards.* This group of courses is missing from your Matrix and may be difficult to map because the standards are crime-scene specific. Please review sub-standards to determine if this set of courses can be mapped. If not, please consider moving this requirement to the General Education or Electives section. Up to 36 credit hours of GE may be required in an AS program. This block could also be considered a "constrained elective" with students choosing one course from a specified list.
