College Cornerstone Requirement changes Effective Date: Fall 2022			

Summary

SoBT/Business Department faculty created a matrix mapping SLS 1331 Course Learning Objectives (CLOs) to required course MAN 2021 in three AS degree programs: Business Analytics, AS; Accounting Technology, AS; and Business Administration and Management, AS. The matrix also maps SLS 1515 CLOs to MAN 2021 and other required courses in these programs. The department is creating a content module for MAN 2021 to cover the two CLOs that are currently unmet in this matrix.

Based on this matrix, the provost has approved changing the College Cornerstone Requirement for AY 2022-2023 and forward such that "Students enrolled in programs that require MAN 2021 will have met the Cornerstone Requirement after successful completion of MAN 2021."

This statement has also been added, based on prior practice: "Students who enroll in and successfully complete IDH 2910 will have met the Cornerstone Requirement."

Review Notes:

1) Deans were notified of these changes in a meeting with the provost on 3/7/22.

2) Potential impacts on pending SoBT Program/Certificate Change proposals were discussed with Dr. Myers on 3/9/22. With Dr. Myers' approval, Dr. Seelau applied changes to affected catalog pages and Curriculog proposals. Dr. Seelau emailed Dr. Myers, Dr. Patterson, and proposal originators copies of redrafted catalog pages for approval, along with additional questions.

Meeting Minutes:

1) If MAN 2021 is taken in an intended program, but the student later changes programs, will MAN 2021 still count as having completed the Cornerstone requirement?

Provost: Yes, but we will make sure language accounts for this.

2) Provost: SLS 1331 will not be included in the catalog statement for the College Cornerstone
 Requirement. This is handled as a substitution in Degree Audits for SoBT students. Assistant Registrar
 T. Maricle will check the coding.

3) Business Chair J. Patterson: Department has found additional areas of overlap between Professional Bus. Skills and Cornerstone. Will use more Cornerstone activities. No change to matrix.

Catalog changes are detailed in the appended memo. The list of courses previously identified as International/Diversity Focus will be removed from the catalog pending reclassification.

- 1) The (I) designation has been retained on individual course pages and may be retained on syllabi pending reclassification.
- 2) GEAC is responsible for distribution and/or accessibility of standards for D, I, GE and WI course designations.
- 3) Department faculty will review existing (I)-designated courses to determine whether the new D and/or I designations will be sought. This process may begin as early as Summer 2022. The provost will offer summer stipends to department faculty to review courses and prepare proposals.
- 4) GEAC and CC leadership will collaborate on a proposal process for consideration of D, I, or both designations, as well as GE and/or WI designations. The submission process will be in place by Fall 2022.
- 5) Beginning in Fall 2022, CC will require attaching a GEAC recommendation to all Course Change and New Course proposals that include D, I, or both designations. CC requires a similar attachment to proposals incorporating a GE and/or WI designation. GEAC will be responsible for advising faculty and CC whether submitted courses meet standards for any designations. Curriculum Committee is responsible for hearing all curricular proposals and voting on acceptance.

6) Details of these committee processes will be shared with faculty in early Fall 2022.

GE Requirements (36 CR): Course lists deleted. Students are now referred to the FSW GEPG.

FSW GE restructuring resulted in 3-CR reduction in COMM, so SPC 1017 or SPC 2608) are no longer required in this program. Students will be advised to take SPC within "Other" GE Requirements.

"Required State Mandated Prerequisite Courses" & "College Mandated Courses for Graduation" sections were deleted, and courses moved to two new sections:

- **Pre-Admission Requirements: 6 Credit Hours**. (PSY 2012 or DEP 2004) [3 CR] moved here from GE Requirements. Students must take one of these courses as a PRQ to Program Requirement EDF 3214. EDF 2005 [3 CR] moved here from "State Mandated Prerequisites."
- Lower Division Program Requirements: 6 Credit Hours section replaces "College Mandated Courses required for Graduation." Courses remain: EDF 2085 and EME 2040.

Electives: now specifies that 12 Credit Hours are required from "Any 1000 to 4000 level courses."

Summary

To meet new State GE/CL requirements and FSW GE restructuring:

- GE Communication reduced from 9 to 6 CR, removing "additional GE COMM." ENC 1101 & 1102 retained. 3 CR moved to *Other GE Requirements.*
- GE Social Sciences reduced from 9 to 6 CR, with Core and CL requirement specified. 3 CR moved to *Other GE Requirements.*
- GE Natural Sciences and *Other GE* categories are now filled with 12 credits of required Core and other GE BSC and/or CHM courses. These courses were moved from a section of Program Specific Requirements (PSR, 16 CR), which has now been deleted.

PSR has been relabeled, "Lower Division Program Requirements," and retains MCB 2010C (4 CR).

No course changes to course content of Upper Division Program Requirements (33 CR). Upper Division Electives (3 CR) now heads the list of constrained elective courses.

Open Electives relabeled, and due to recategorizing Science requirements, increases from 32 to 44 CR of 1000-4000 level courses.

GE 36 CR + LDPR 4 CR + UDPR 33 CR + UDE = 3 CR + OE 44 CR = 120 CR.

Due to permanent changes in professional workplace practices initiated during the Covid crisis, the HIT AS program director has modified 3 Professional Practice Experience courses (PPE I-III) from internships at community agencies to medical office simulations in an asynchronous online modality.

FDOE framework for HIT AS program, state-mandated General Education requirements, and the move to online modality support the decision to **reduce the credit hours** on this course **from 3 to 2**. The online modality allows **decreasing contact hours from 6 to 3**. This mirrors current practices of remote medical coders.

Course title, course description, topic outline, and learning outcomes changed to reflect current practices, content, and modality.

Add program restrictions: Health Information Technology, AS and/or Medical Information Coder/Biller, CCC.

Updated prerequisites and corequisites provide necessary knowledge and training to succeed in this course. **Add Corequisite:** HIM 2253. **Prerequisites:** HIM 1800C with a grade of "C" or better (no change); **add:** HIM 2724 with a grade of "C" or better, and permission of HIT Program Director.

The structure of this course is the same as **HIM 1800C** (Item 9), with lecture and "lab"/simulation each week, for a total of 2 credit hours and 3 contact hours. Dr. McClinton advised the same change - Request SCNS designate HIM 2813 as a "C" course.

Summary

Program page has been completely reorganized and streamlined.

Course-related changes to Narratives:

1) **Purpose/Admission Requirements:** Deleted requirement that "all GE courses, foreign language competency, and RN-to-BSN Program Specific courses must be completed before applying."

2) **Program Structure:** 120 CR now consist of 36 GE, 9 CR Lower Division Program Requirements, 30 CR Upper Division RN-to-BSN Program Requirements, 45 CR Electives (1000-4000 level). Students must complete all GE before enrolling in NUR 2827C in last semester of study.

Changes made to meet FDOE GE/CL requirements and FSW GE restructuring:

"General Education and RN to BSN Specific Prerequisite Requirements: 42 Credits" category changed to: **General Education Requirements: 36 CR** and **Lower Division Program Requirements: 9 CR**. To offset the 3-credit net increase, **Electives** decrease from 48 to **45 CR**.

- Added GE Social Science with Civic Literacy courses recommended in place of DEP 2004. [GE Core SocSci remains (PSY 2012 or SYG 1000).]
- Moved (SPC 1017 or SPC 2608) [3 CR] and DEP 2004 (3 CR) from GE [Comm and Soc Sci] to Lower Division Program Requirements. HUN 1201 Human Nutrition (3 CR) completes this category.
 - Dr. Such noted: "HUN 1201 was inadvertently removed in the current catalog but is still on the graduation audit and is a required program course. Added this course back in here."
- GE Natural Sciences: "12 CR including RN to BSN Specific Prerequisites" statement struck. No specific program prerequisite courses were listed. Students will now be required to take the following 12 credits to complete the GE Natural Sciences (Core and other NS 6 CR) and GE Other (6 CR) requirements: MCB 2010C [4 CR], (BSC 1086C or BSC 1094C) [4 CR], and (BSC 1086C or BSC 1094C) [4 CR].
