Programs of Study

Purpose

The Homeland Security Specialist College Credit Certificate (CCC) prepares students to work in law enforcement, homeland security, private/industry security, and other criminal justice, legal or public service-related fields. The certificate prepares students to work as criminal justice or homeland security practitioners, supervisors, or managers in law enforcement agencies and homeland security organizations. The certificate may also be beneficial to professionals seeking incentive benefits or career enhancement as it provides supplemental training for persons previously or currently employed in these occupations.

Program Structure

This program is a planned sequence of instruction consisting of 9 credit hours of Homeland Security Specialist Requirements.

Certificate Completion/Graduation

All courses within the Homeland Security Specialist CCC must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. Students must fulfill all requirements of their program to be eligible for graduation. Students must indicate their intention to attend commencement ceremony by completing the Commencement Form by the published deadline.
