Course Title* Nursing Concepts: Families in Crisis-Complex Health Problems

Course Description* This course is designed to further develop the concepts within FSW nursing philosophy: Health, People and nursing as a profession. Emphasis is placed on the concepts of health-wellness-illness, collaboration, managing care, safety, advocacy, legal issues, policy, healthcare systems, ethics, accountability, evidence-based practice, and complex communication concepts. This course also provides clinical experiences for students to explore and solidify the concepts covered in Nursing Concepts: Families in Crisis-Complex Health Problems. Students will progress from directly supervised clinical experiences to a more independent and indirectly supervised clinical nurse residency experience. Assignments in this course will immerse students into the patient/client care environment, preparing them for the transition from student nurse to professional registered nurse. Upon completion the students will be able to provide safe and effective care for patients/clients and families in a community context.

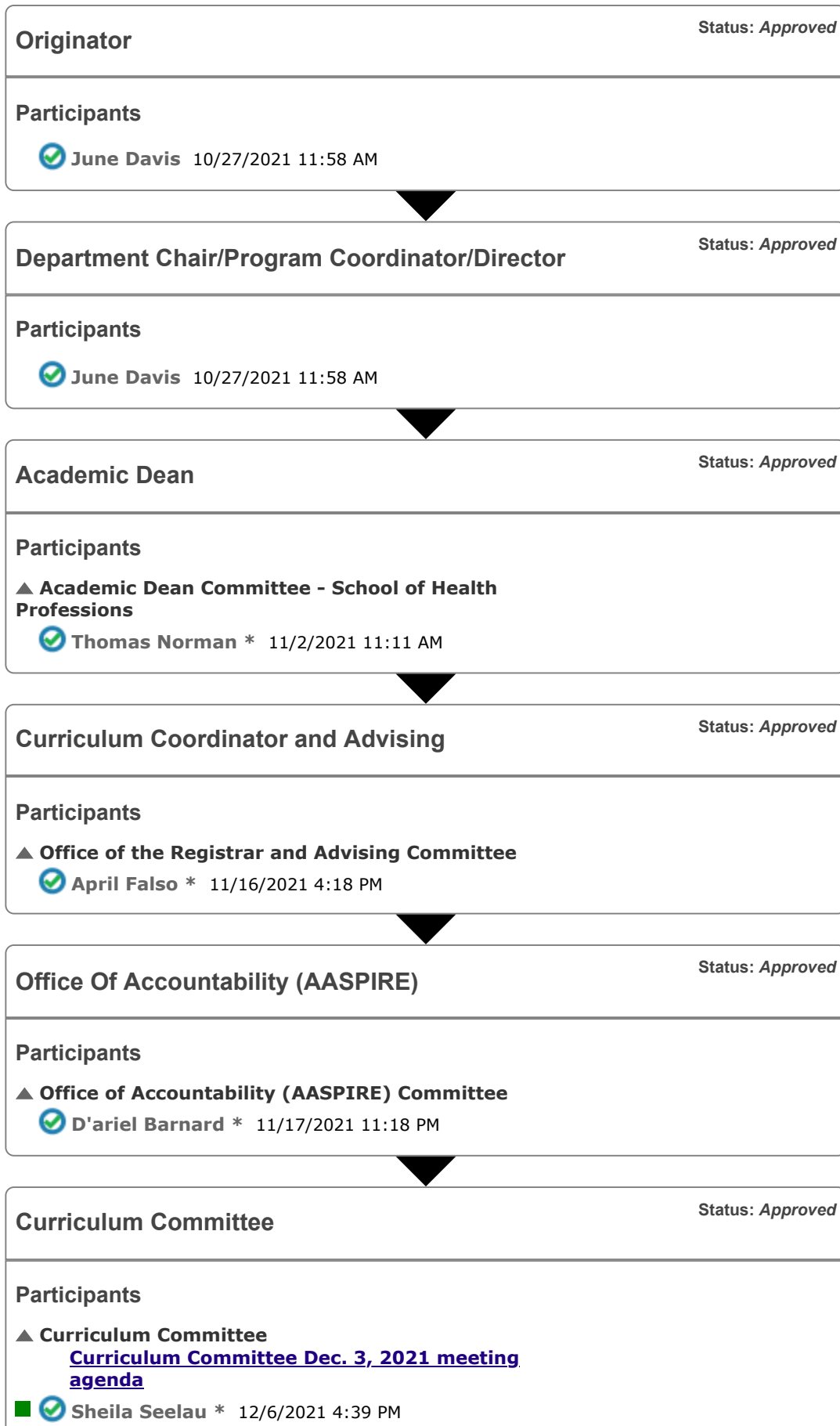
