Hi, Dr. DeLuca.

I need your guidance on a curriculum issue. One of the classes in the new BAS-IST was removed in error last year via the 5-year deletion rule (I did not see it on the list, and it was my error).

The program is in the 2021/2022 catalog (hidden). Now that the program is fully approved, we would like to activate the program page in the 2021/2022 FSW catalog and put a big banner on top: Beginning in fall 2021! and add it to the list of programs in the catalog. This will give our advisors a good resource for recruiting, and students can see what the curriculum looks like.

The problem is - ISM 4153 Enterprise Information Systems is missing because it was deactivated, so the program page is not accurate.

There are two options to fix this through the Curriculum Committee:

- Submit an exception memo asking that ISM4153 be reinstated for 2021/2022. This would allow us to activate it in the catalog. Jeffrey Peterman would send the notice to the state.
- Put a Program change through for 2022/2023 and keep the program hidden the 2021/2022 catalog.
