When Faculty put paperwork through to combine NUR 4827C Leadership... and NUR 4955 Nursing Capstone, Tim Maricle interpreted Informatics which was entered twice into the prerequisite box was suppose to be NUR 4870 Informatics and NUR 4165 Nursing Research and that it had never been put in the catalog or banner system and he did so for AY 2022-23. Tim Maricle relayed to B. Holbrook, that the only way we can get Registrar to stop NUR 4165 N. Research to be a prerequisite of NUR 4827C Leadership in Nursing Practice is for a BSN Faculty to present the argument to the FSW Curriculum Committee and say the Informatics being entered twice on the Curriculum change for was not intended to be NUR 3870 and NUR4165.
