### A. <u>Discussion:</u>

#### C. Discussion:

### D. Discussion:

An update on a potential bachelor's program was shared. This is in the planning phase. Advisory Committee will need to have input before we proceed. The BAS degree would be a potential pathway for HIT graduates and lead to professional credentials.

#### Action:

1. Information will be shared with Advisory Committee and survey will be built and sent.

## E. <u>Discussion</u>:

It was discussed that we should decide which courses we will begin offering Flex Online. Elizabeth expressed that she feels students need coding courses face-to-face and we will work to have these courses scheduled as Flex Live Online as some students still are not able to come to campus and require online.

### **Action:**

- 2. Part of the revisions to the HIT and MICB program will include the scheduling of courses.
- 3. We will move to put the coding courses on the schedule as Flex Live Online.
