Special notes:

- Curriculum Changes
 - Next curriculum committee meeting April 7th, 2023.
 - PD Scott states that she would like for the team to evaluate all syllabi and move objectives around for the courses, so that the information is not so redundant. In addition, we can now focus on incorporating more peripheral and structural heart content into one of the courses.
 - Additional classes for Fall are pending the committee's approval.

- Simulation Tie-In
 - Discussion held between CVT faculty/staff and Dr. Buhain, Simulation Director, on tying in cases/practice in the simulation center for CVT 1800C and CVT 2205 courses.
 - Team's action plan
 - Create simulation course objectives
 - Meet in May with objectives to plan for the course switch day
- Check In
 - Dr. Nicole Cobb
 - States that she is noticing student fatigue.
 - Also notices a lack of responsiveness from the students.
 - 5 students failed the last Pharmacology exam.
 - Having some issues with H5P
 - Director Scott will follow up on.
 - Professor Lenius
 - Doing well but is worried about one of the students. One student has not passed any of the quizzes and should not move forward because he does not know the material.
 - Professor Bennett is making the student go over the exams and look up the questions and answers to the ones he got incorrect.
 - Professor Bennett
 - With the current situation, Professor Bennett states that she is worried about the temperament of the 2023 cohort.
 - Director Scott
 - Currently worried about the situation with a student wanting to bring a lawyer in for a meeting to discuss her CVT 2840L.
 - Student has had multiple late clock-ins and is already setting on a C in the course. She will most likely fail. At least 3 sites do not want to work with her. Professor Bennett reached out to her to discuss the situation with a meeting. The student responded by wanting her lawyer to be present. After reporting this up the ladder, administration has asked for the team to meet to go over the plan from this day forward.
- Fall Scheduling/Simple Syllabus
 - Simple Syllabus training has started. Planned implementation is Fall 2023. This is a chance to polish up our syllabi, especially with curriculum changes pending.
