Other Information

Check-In

- o Under the new curriculum, courses went smoothly.
- Instructors are asked to use the course rubric to review all the courses taught this Fall.

CVT 1000

- o The hurricane knocked the class off course by a couple of days
- o Professor Lenius is worried that there may still be too much respiratory involved in the course.
 - Wants to bring PD Newberry into the CVT 2620 course in the Spring for a guest lecture.
 - PD Scott stated that there will be respiratory taught in CVT 2205 Advanced Cardiac Care.
- The team will look at making the book optional.

CVT 1800C

- o Professor Bennett would like to keep the didactic and lab portions separate moving forward.
 - She feels good owning the whole course. The team supports this decision and feels that it is better for the students.

Spring Schedule

- Professor Bennett will own CVT 1800C.
- o Instructor Office Hours are due by January 5th, 2024.

Summer Schedule

- o Professor Bennett and PD Scott will teach the summer courses for 2024.
- The team will look at removing the echo rotation and use that time to place students into the cardiac rehabilitation unit.

• Fall Schedule

- o Tentative schedule has been created.
 - Schedule allows second year students to come in and help with lab. This alleviates the need for multiple clinical associates.
- The schedule is created without a full-time faculty member. This means that PD Scott, Professor Bennett, and Adjunct Lenius will be teaching the courses unless someone is hired as a full-time faculty.
- Employer Surveys & Annual Report
 - Surveys went out on December 1st, 2023.
 - Erin R. no longer works at HealthPark so we will need to send the survey to the new manager.
 - We need to find a contact at Physicians Regional to get an employer survey.

Syllabi Updates

- All syllabi changes were due by December 1st, 2023.
- All curriculum changes have been approved.
 - Changes will show in the Fall 2024 catalog.
- Program Expansion/Program Development Curriculog
 - o There are no updates from administration at this time.

Clinic

- We have MOUs from TGH/HealthPark/NCH.
- o The hotel has been booked for Spring 2024 Rotation 3.
 - The hotel has guaranteed us a locked in rate for Spring and Summer 2024.

Clinical Associate Recruitment

- PD Scott checking on pay increase across the SoHP.
 - CA pay was increased last year for the CVT program, so the increase may not have affected our program.
- PD Scott is working on a flyer to send out to the clinical affiliates.
 - We are also reaching out to the students to see who their favorite preceptor is so we can reach out to them directly.

- PD Scott is planning to setup visits to staff meetings to express our need for CAs.
- o Full-Time Faculty Recruitment
 - Professor Lenius plans to step down to Adjunct position for the Fall.
 - He will turn in his paperwork when we return from Winter break.
 - Advertising for his job will begin once paperwork has been placed.
 - Professor Lenius asked for a heads up if we find someone to hire. That way he can setup his payments from FRS.
- o Final Grades/Students of Concern
 - We are losing 1 student from the class of 2025. (15)
 - Salomon S. (H22)
 - We are losing 1 student from the class of 2024 (11)
 - Dayanna G. (recycle)
 - We will need to create a new policy for check-offs to be placed in the handbook.
- Inventory & Equipment Updates
 - Our TV monitor has been placed and our simulator has arrived.
 - Waiting for Alex from Mentice to send me a date for training.
 - o Cardiac cath packs have arrived in America.
 - The packs will probably arrive during the Winter break.
 - Professor Bennett stated that we needed transducers with the line on them to connect to our manifolds.
 - We also need a steel table for the 3rd simulation station and a peg board for the back wall.
- CVT Club Updates
 - o \$250.00 was donated for the American Heart Association Walk.
 - The team is asked to support the second years with their t-shirt fundraiser.
- Preceptorship Training
 - We are trying to find a way to fundraise the preceptor memberships.
 - o We cannot use the foundation funds, so the Dean has asked the students to fundraise for it.
 - PD Scott is following up with Lauren Finn to see if this is possible.
- Lambda Nu
 - We are looking at opening up membership in the Spring so that students can fulfill a volunteer experience. Right now, we have a few students who qualify. They will be emailed in the Spring.
- Marketing Application Season
 - o The program goal is 50 applicants.
 - We will use the BB Mann sign, TVs around the school, and posted brochures.
 - Additional advertisement will be done through Medical Terminology and A & P courses, open houses, and on-campus events.
 - PD Scott also to follow up with marketing on social media advertisments.
