Check-In

- We are still teaching out old courses and bringing in new curriculum.
- Currently we have 15 first years and 11 second years.
- Summer Schedule
  - Professor Bennett and PD Scott will teach the summer courses for 2024.
  - Professor Bennett asked that the Summer schedule be checked in Banner because she is seeing two courses listed for CVT 2842. PD Scott will follow up with Tamra on this.
- Fall Schedule
  - Tentative schedule has been created.
    - Schedule allows second year students to come in and help with lab. This alleviates the need for multiple clinical associates.
  - The schedule is created without a full-time faculty member. This means that PD Scott, Professor Bennett, and Adjunct Lenius will be teaching the courses unless someone is hired as a full-time faculty.
- Employer Surveys
  - Surveys went out on December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023.
    - Erin R. no longer works at Health Park so we will need to send the survey to the new manager.
      - One completed by Lauren Pope. PD Scott following up via email to get the other responses.
    - We need to find a contact at Physicians Regional to get an employer survey.
- Clinic
  - We have MOUs from TGH/Health Park/NCH.
  - The hotel has been booked for Spring 2024 Rotation 3.
    - The hotel has guaranteed us a locked in rate for Spring and Summer 2024.
- Clinical Associate Recruitment
  - PD Scott sent a flyer to send out to the clinical affiliates.
    - We are also reaching out to the students to see who their favorite preceptor is so we can reach out to them directly.
    - PD Scott is planning to setup visits to staff meetings to express our need for CAs.
      - Miki Morales resigned for this semester.
  - o Full-Time Faculty Recruitment
    - Professor Lenius plans to step down to Adjunct position for the Fall.
      - He will turn in his paperwork the second week on the semester.
    - Advertising for his job will begin once paperwork has been placed.
    - Professor Lenius asked for a heads up if we find someone to hire. That way he can
