### Other Information

Special notes:

- Check-In
  - The team reviewed what went well and did not go well this semester.
    - We lost 8 students from the freshmen cohort (61.8%).
      - The course schedule was overwhelming for the freshmen. Look at separating the courses more through the week. Instead of having the students come two days, make them come three days.
      - Hurricanes set us back.
      - Freshmen struggled with gas exchange.
      - We need to increase course hours for CVT 2421.

- Students missed shunts
- We will need to find someone new for pictures this semester.
- Sophomore cohort was way more challenging this semester with tardies and absences.
- Freshmen were really engaged and kept instructors in the loop on days that they would be late.
- Pharmacology went better with the new course design. However, students struggled because they would not read the directions.
- Clinic
  - Halley stated that students are doing well.
    - Jacob and Madison are the top two.
    - We will need to keep an eye on Clemencia.
  - Clinic MOUs
    - TGH -signed
    - Gulf Coast signed
    - Health Park signed
    - NCH signed
    - Manatee legal counsel declined
- Inventory & Equipment Updates
  - Items arrived but need to be put up in the lab.
- Non-Invasive Program
  - Grant from FutureMakers was not approved. The administration is taking it to the state for funding. We will know something next year.
- CVT Advisory Board Meeting & Pinning Ceremony
  - The meeting will be held on Thursday, April 17<sup>th</sup>, 2025 in A 207. The pinning ceremony will be on Friday, April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Due to construction, the AA 177 room will not be available for use so we will need to use another space.
    - PD Scott to reserve the previous location (theater) for pinning.
    - Halley stated that there is no money in the club account and that the students will need to fundraise.

- Curriculum Changes
